Assessment Increase

As you are already aware, the Belmont Business Improvement District has been working closely with the Department of Small Business Services on increasing our assessment. After much review and consideration the increase has been accepted and the Mayoral Bill Signing Ceremony will be happening in early February. The Belmont BID's assessment will now be \$440,000. This increase was not a decision the BID took lightly, however in order to operate as efficiently as possible it was decided that it was needed in order to maintain our high level of service, which has proven to be so vital to the success of our district. The BID's Board of Directors felt it is as important as ever to create a cleaner, safer, more beautiful and vibrant district. The assessment increase was applied for Fiscal Year 2016, and as a result it will be collected retroactively. Subsequently, your next bill will be higher than the one after that. App Allows Drivers To Pay For Metered Parking on Smartphone

A mobile app that allows visitors to pay for their metered parking through their phone will be coming to Belmont permanently this year. Drivers will be able to download the app and sign up with their credit card and license place number, then punch in the muni meter number to pay with a click. Money can now be added from anywhere - instead of having to run back to the car to feed the meter when it's about to expire. This is a convenient way for customers to pay for parking and will contribute to a decrease in the amount of parking tickets written in the neighborhood. Customers will still have the option to pay at the meter.

Bronx Little Italy Map & Directory

The BID is currently in the process of creating a brochure that will open into an illustrated map of the neighborhood and business directory. All businesses in the BID district will be featured in the directory, however if you would like to be highlighted on the illustrated map you must contact the BID directly by the end of February. If you choose to highlight your business, your logo and website or phone number will be drawn onto the map by your business location. These brochures will be distributed throughout the neighborhood and to local institutions. Large images of the map will also be displayed throughout the neighborhood in high traffic areas.

Upcoming Events

The Belmont BID is really looking forward to our upcoming events for the year. Our Car Show will be on Sunday, May 1st and will take place on Crescent Avenue. In case of rain, the event will be held on Sunday, May 15th. In June we have an Art Show planned for Saturday the 11th on East 186th Street. Once again, we're partnering up with Saint Barnabas Hospital to host a health fair on Sunday, August 28th on Crescent Avenue. Ferragosto is sure to be bigger and better than ever this year. On Sunday, September 11th, Ferragosto will take place on Arthur Avenue, but it will be expanded to include an Art Show from East 187th Street to East 188th Street. New for this year is a Bocce Ball Tournament in Ciccarone Park scheduled for Columbus Day, Monday, October 10th. The year will come to a close with our Annual Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony on Saturday, December 3rd in Ciccarone Park.
